Dr. Adam Elhofy is a Vice President in the Chicago office of Sikich Investment Banking. Adam has over 14 years of scientific research experience in the areas of immunology, neuroscience, and oncology. Adam leads the scientific evaluation of many due diligence efforts for the Life Science Funds for which Sikich advises on an ongoing basis.

Prior to joining Sikich, Adam was the Principal Investigator of a nanotech startup with technology spun off from Argonne Laboratories, where he led the proof of principle effort and applied for SBIR funding.
